The Venue

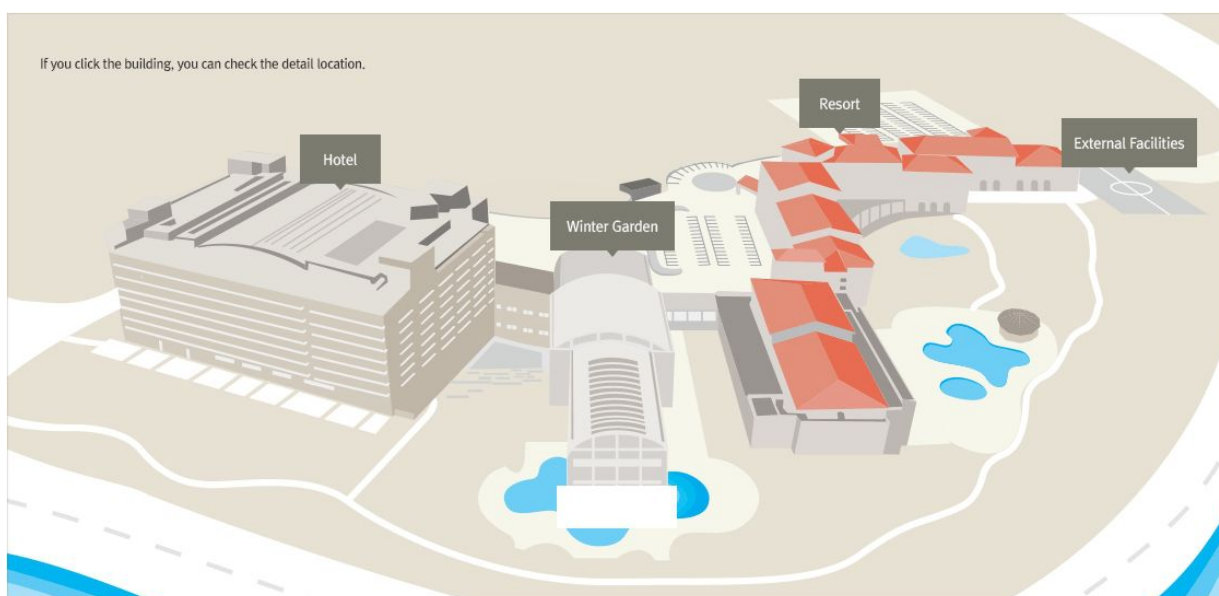
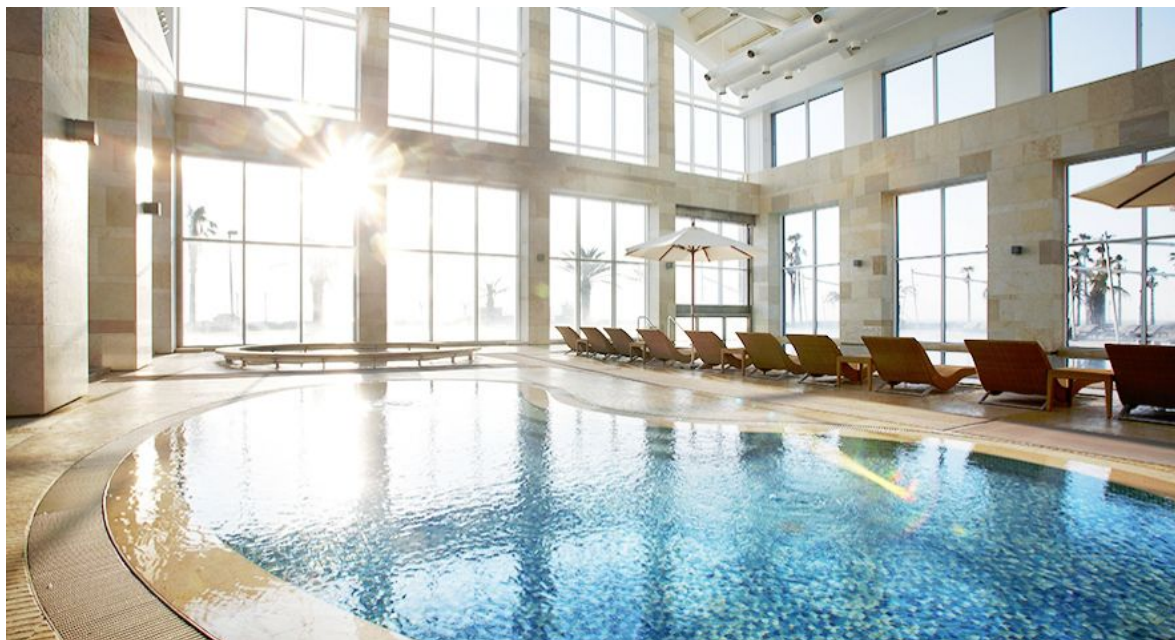


Haevichi Hotels & Resorts
