3. Introductions of Major Rules Adopted by those Events

➤ MCR

• Mainly based on *China Mahjong Competition Rules* issued by China National Sports General Administration of sport in 1998, which is called Version 98 in China. MCR used commonly in Europe is called Version 06, which is originated from Version 98 with less difference. Rules Committee of MIL Preparatory Committee will make the clarification of the two versions 98 & 06, and use an updated MCR according to the full development in China, Japan& Europe.

Riichi

• World Riichi Championship Rules 2015 is recommended.

Sichuan Bloody

 The rule is widely used near Sichuan Province of China. MIL Preparatory Rules Committee of MIL Preparatory Committee will make a formal clarification of the Sichuan Bloody.

4. Competition Formats

General Format

 Scoring unit is as individual: after 1 round, 2 rounds or 1 session, rank according to the present individual scores, and then gain the individual table points.

Duplicated Format for Team

- 4 teams are set into one group and each team has 4 players. The 4 players from each team will sit at East, South, West and North of 4 different tables respectively. Same tiles of each hand will be discarded to the 4 tables. For each hand, the scores from 4 players sitting in different tables should be accumulated as the team score, and then the team score will be converted into team IMP. After some certain hands, the sums of IMPs of each team will be the final results for competition comparison.
- For the duplicated format, Swiss Shift, Elimination Games and Circulation Games can be organized based on IMPs.

Duplicated Format for Individual

- All tables play the same tiles and each player gets his original scores after each hand.
 According to the players` original scores sitting at the same direction, we can get 4 relative rankings for 4 different directions. For one certain player, his ranking can be converted into standard points of each hand at his certain direction.
- After some certain hands, the sums of standard points of the certain player will be the final results for competition comparison at his certain direction. That means there will be 4 Champions of 4 directions.

> Other Formats (Lap Event, Survival Event and Pair Event, etc)

Based on General Format, factors with entertainment and participatory are introduced

5. Introductions of Events

Main Events (Official Competition)

Event#1 Individual Competition

Rules: MCR

• Format: After 10 Sessions as preliminary, top 64 players shall be qualified to the Semi-final.

Duplicated Format for Individual is used during the Semi-final and Final. 2 sessions for

Semi-final with 64 to 16; 2 more sessions for Final with the top 16 ranking.

Players: 500 players are expected

> Event#2 Team Competition

Rules: MCR

• Format: Duplicated format for Team. Swiss Shift is used from Session 1 to Session 3 for 16 to

8; then 2 Sessions for 8 to 4;2 Sessions for the final.

Players: 16 teams, 4 players for each team, totally 64 players are expected.

Mahjong Carnival (Exhibition Events)

Event#3 Japan Mahjong Event

• Rules: Riichi (*World Riichi Championship Rules 2015* is recommended)

• Format: One session has one Hanchan(East-South). Round Robin is used for the 7 sessions

of preliminary, and the top 16 players are qualified; 2 sessions for semi-final and top 4

qualified; 3 sessions for final.

Players: 100 players are expected

Event#4 Quick-Survival Event

Rules: MCR

• Format: Each player has 60 initial points. The players shall be eliminated after losing all

points, and then the remaining players will be re-arranged. Players can join in before 10:30,

but cannot re-entrance once eliminated.

• Players: 200 players are expected.

Event#5 Quick-Lap Event

Rules: MCR

• Format: One session has 1 round. Score 4-2-1-0 after each session. Rank according to the

total scores of 8 sessions.

Players: 200 players are expected.

> Event #6 Sichuan Mahjong Event

Rules: Sichuan Bloody

• Format: One session has 1 round. Score 4-2-1-0 after each session. Rank according to the

total scores of 8 sessions.

• Players: 80 players are expected

Event #7 Quick-Lap Event

Rules: MCR

Format: One session has 1 round. Score 4-2-1-0 after each session. Rank according to the

total scores of 8 sessions.

Players: 200 players are expected

Event#8 Pair Event

• Rules: Based on MCR. One hand shall be ended until 2 players declare to WIN. During one

hand, the first winner shall gain the present points and quit the following draw&discard

procedure, and then the other 3 players continue to play until the second player declare to

WIN, with the second winner gain the points among the remaining 3 players. The result of

one hand shall be calculated by the points of two WINs respectively.

• Format: 2 players as one Pair can sign up. One session has 1 round and totally 8 sessions. The

final ranking shall be according to the points of each Pair.

• Players: 40 pairs are expected.

> Event #9 Team Event of MCR

Rules: MCR

• Format: Each team has 4 players without specific requirements. Duplicated format for team

is used. One session has 1 round. Swiss shift shall be used for the first 8 sessions and the top

4 teams are qualified. 4 sessions for Final.

• Players: 80 players are expected.

Event#10 Team Event of Riichi

• Rules: Riichi (*World Riichi Championship Rules 2015* is recommended)

• Format: Duplicated format for team. One session has 1 round and totally 6 sessions.

Players: 32 players are expected.

Event#11 Ms. Event

Rules: MCR

Format: Woman player has initial 200 points and man has 50 points. Players shall be

eliminated after losing all points and then the remaining players will be re-arranged.

• Players: 80 players are expected.

Remarks: Concern about the female players` perspective, strict etiquette and other special

rules shall be taken.

6. Qualification

Main Events (Official Competition)

- Event#1 Individual Competition
 - MIL members can help all the players to register before Sep. 30th.
 - MIL shall appoint some internet platforms to select players before Oct. 15th.
 - Personal registration or on-site registration shall not be accepted.
- Event#2 Team Competition
 - Each member of MIL can send 1 team as representative in principle before Aug. 31st.
 According to the registration order, the first 16 teams shall be accepted.
 - A joint team among different countries shall be allowed on condition that not enough players for one country. The number of teams may be adjusted depends on the real situation.
 - Personal registration or on-site registration shall not be accepted.

Mahjong Carnival (Exhibition Events)

Event #3- Event #12 Tickets is required for all the exhibition events. On-site registration is allowed. Players who are not involved in Event#1 or Event #2 can join in on-site.

7. Fees

- Players should pay their own travel expenses.
- Players for the Team Competition as national representatives are provided with board and lodging by sponsors from Oct 23rd to 28th (6 nights).
- Players not involved for the Team Competition should pay their own expenses of board and lodging. The Organizing Committee will provide recommended hotels with contract prices.
- ➤ Main events: Event #1 Individual Competition, Event#2 Team Competition
 - No registration fee.

- Mahjong Carnival (Exhibition Events): Event #3- Event #11
 - All Carnival events will be held in specified areas called Mahjong Carnival Areas. Daily tickets
 are required to enter the Mahjong Carnival Areas, which to make sure the high level events
 and good orders.
 - Price of Daily ticket from Oct 26th to 28th is RMB¥150 (US\$ 25). Price of 3-days package(from Oct 26th to 28th) is RMB¥300 (US\$50).
 - No registration fee and additional charge.

8. Prizes

- ➤ Main Events: Event#1 Team Competition, Event #2 Individual Competition
 - Top 3 team and top 3 individual players will achieve Gold, Silver and Bronze medal respectively, comparing to 2008 Beijing Olympic Games.
 - Top 4 team and top 16 individual players will gain certifications and master points issued by
 MIL, and mysterious awards provided by sponsors.
- Mahjong Carnival (Exhibition Events):
 - For Event#3 Japan Mahjong Event: Top 3 individual players will achieve Gold, Silver and Bronze medal respectively. Top 16 individual players will gain certifications and master points issued by MIL, and mysterious awards provided by sponsors.
 - Other Events (Event #4- Event #11): The championship will achieve Gold medal. Top 4
 individual players will gain certifications and master points issued by MIL, and mysterious
 awards provided by sponsors.

9. Goals

- Large-scale
 - More than 500 players will participate in the events.
 - The largest number of participants of competitive mahiging sports games is expected.

Internationalization

- Players from nearly 40 countries and regions will participate in the events.
- The largest number of countries and regions of competitive mahiging sports games is expected.

Towards Mind Sports

- Duplicated format is used, which is the most reasonable and fair games.
- Enough hands, rounds and sessions to make sure that each player has opportunity to show his strength.

Medias Open

- Widely media spread by various tools before the events.
- Living broadcast will be applied during all the events, to improve the ornamentals of Mahjong Games.

Open for all Rules

- Includes various popular rules, such as MCR, Riichi, Sichuan Rules, following the road map as
 "Playing Agreements Sports Rules Sportify Mind Game"
- Mahjong Carnival: Various formats for competitions and funs.
